All entries for the Area Meet will be done through Track for Life – Seth Brower. Once your District Meet is over, the meet results will be forwarded to Seth Brower via Hy-Tek Meet Results File so the Area Meet Program can be created. In similar fashion to the Regional Meet, lane assignments and field event order will be randomly generated using the Hy-Tek software.

The Schedule of Events and Worker Assignments are provided with this letter. Please carry out your work assignments in a professional manner so that we may run a quality Area Meet.

We will attempt to adjust the schedule as needed to give any athlete from District 25 or District 26 that is competing in the Regional Academic or One-Act-Play the opportunity to compete in their event.

Communication is a must from both districts once coaches know of any conflict with the meet schedule prior to the district meet dates. Once the district meets are complete on April 16th, the schedule of events for the area meet will be final.

Scratch Meeting:	N/A
Awards:	Packaged for Pickup
Team Camps:	No teams will be allowed to set up camp in the infield. All camps must be outside of the stadium. No radios, boom boxes or other noisemakers will be permitted.
Concessions:	Concessions will be open at the stadium.
Restrooms:	Restrooms will be open at concession stand areas.
Weather:	In the event of bad weather, we will ask everyone to go to gym until weather has passed.
Finish Line Procedures:	We will be using the Finish Lynx timing system with Hy-Tek Meet Manager. One finish line will be used throughout the meet.
Field Events & Relays:	No tape or any other adhesive markers will be allowed on any part of the track. Please use tennis balls or any type of rubber marker to mark the track and/or runway surfaces. Please DO NOT USE CHALK for start marks or check point marks.
Field events:	All NFHS rules including weigh-ins of implements and athletes will be followed. Shots and discs will be pooled. Note: All pole vault poles must have the original manufacturer's tag indicating the weight of the pole.
Assignments:	Each school will be responsible for running off a field event and curve judge. Each school will have a timer and picker assigned and ready in case of technology difficulties.
